Use the following guidelines in preparing your provisional plan:

- Use the courses in your major program, in the recommended sequence, as the framework of your schedule.
- Plan an average of four to six courses (depending on your major) each regular quarter. Summer may be used to reach an average load of 45 units each year.
- Use "elective" spaces in your program to satisfy General Education, College, and (optional) minor requirements. Taking General Education courses is an excellent way to explore new areas.
- Satisfying University, General Education, College, and major requirements will not meet the minimum 180 units or 64 upper division units required to graduate. Plan for courses to meet this additional unit requirement as needed.

- in the College of Letters and Science Deans' Office
- in appropriate optional programs, such as pre-professional advising or minor departments
