First Quarter Schedule Notes:

- Do not enroll in upper division courses (numbered 100 or above), unless instructed otherwise by Major Advisor
- Students cannot take more than one German Lower Division course at a time.
- If students want to get ahead on their electives, they can take up to three outside electives that do not have prerequisites from our list of accepted outside courses towards the GER Major.

Placement Exams

Foreign Language Placement is Situational: Not required:

- If student has any AP Score of 3, 4, or 5, consult the AP chart for guidance.
- If student has no prior German language experience from high school or home, they would start in GER 001.
- If student has taken German courses at a community college or any other college, consult with an advisor if unsure of next class.
- If student took only GER 1 and GER 2 in high school, they would start in GER 002.

Required:

- If student took a higher level than GER 2 in high school
- If student has an AP score of 2 or less
- If student has an IB score that does not satisfy the foreign language requirement

Not Required

Math: The German Major does not require the Math Placement Exam. If you plan to take Math courses, be sure to review placement requirements prior to enrollment.

Chemistry: The German Major does not require the Chemistry Placement Exam. If you plan to take Chemistry courses, be sure to review placement requirements prior to enrollment.

Computer Science: The German Major does not require the Computer Science Placement Exam. If you plan to take Computer Science courses, be sure to review placement requirements prior to enrollment.

Recommended First Year Goals

- Visit Major Advisor at least once per quarter.
- Visit and get to know the Peer Advisor.
- Visit and get to know their instructors.
- Use instructors' office hours as often as possible.

AP-German Language and Culture	4	GER 20	No repeat. Must go to GER 21
AP-German Language and Culture	3	GER 3	No repeat. Must go to GER 20
IB-German A: Language and Literature	5, 6, 7	GER 3	No repeat. Must go to GER 20
