Placement Exams

Recommended

Foreign Language: All students pursuing an A.B. degree in the College of Letters and Science complete a Foreign Language through the 15-unit level (For example: through SPA 003 or above.) Please see the UC Davis Language Center website for details on course placement or proficiency exams if you have familiarity with a language other than English.

Not Required

Math: The Theatre and Dance Major does not require the Math Placement Exam. If you plan to take Math courses in the future, taking the Math Placement Exam now is a good idea.

Chemistry: The Theatre and Dance Major does not require the Chemistry Placement Exam. If you plan to take Chemistry courses be sure to review placement requirements prior to enrollment.

Computer Science: The Theatre and Dance Major does not require the Chemistry Placement Exam. If you plan to take Computer Science courses, be sure to review placement requirements prior to enrollment.

Recommended First Year Goals

- □ Complete at least three lower division courses that will satisfy the Theatre and Dance major by the end of your first year.
- Meet with a Theatre and Dance peer advisor to learn about how to get involved in department theatre or dance stage productions. Earning units as a backstage crew member during a production during your first year at UC Davis is a great way to get involved and meet other students in the major.

On Stage and Behind the Scenes

Committing your time to a crew, production, or participating on stage in a show to complete a total of 12 units of DRA 180A-G or DRA 145 courses over a period of four years are required for this major. These courses are added to your schedule by entering a "course record number" (CRN) which is given to you by the leading stage manager, faculty, lecturer or staff. Speak with a major advisor for more details.

During your first year, you are welcome to audition for our shows to earn DRA 145 or DRA 180A units, and after completion of DRA 028, participate in theatre laboratory and crew assignments: DRA 180D or DRA 180 E, F, or G.
